Bourdieu's sociology, particularly his concept of the habitus, is firmly anchored within the sociology of translation, resulting chiefly from the works of individual researchers (in alphabetical order Gouanvic, Inghillieri, Sela-Sheffy, Simeoni, Wolf). This research has provided an impetus for an increasing number of mostly doctoral and post-doctoral research projects, which adopt the habitus concept as an "analytical tool".
